The **Family Portal** is a way that your family and friends can see your information.



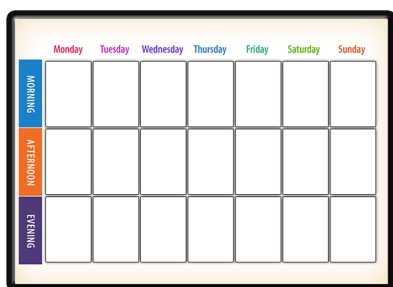
Usually, the more information about your daily life we can share with your family and friends, the better your support will be.

What information you can share on the Family Portal



You can share your calendar.
This means your family and friends will know what your plans are.



You can share photos so your family and friends can see the best bits of your day.



You can share your **daily records**.
Your **daily records** say what you have done each day like what activities you have done or what you have eaten. This helps your family and friends find out a bit more about your day.



You can share your **Activate Outcomes**.
Your **Activate Outcomes** are the things you are doing to meet the goals in your support plan.



Sharing your information



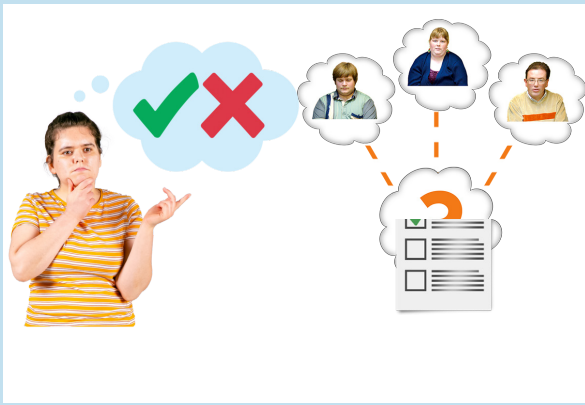
We will only share information on the **Family Portal** that you tell us it is ok to share.



You can choose what information you want to share on the **Family Portal**.



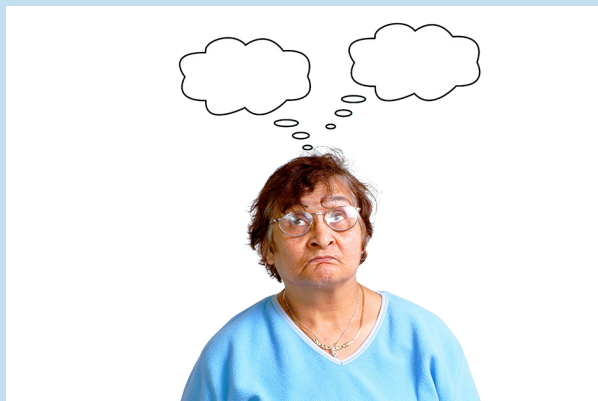
You can choose who sees your information on the **Family Portal**.
