All data on testing (and vaccinations) available on RADAR.

Visits to services by families and friends

No visits allowed during lockdown apart from in exceptional circumsatnces.

People in Registered Care Homes allowed one regular visitor. Tests and PPE required. People can meet outdoors, including in private gardens; Rule of Six reintroduced. We follow government advice if it increases the number of regular visitors allowed to two. Government will review social distancing rules.

No legal limits on social contact.

Visits to services by colleagues and contractors

Essential visits only, incl. by managers, quality reviewers, health & safety, etc.
