



## Glossary of terms and Jargon buster

Here is a list of common words and terms used in social care and their meanings.

AAC	Augmentative and Alternative Communication
ABI	Acquired brain injury
ADASS	Association of Directors of Adult Social Services
ADD/ADHD	Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder
Advocαcy	Getting support from another person to help you with the people you support express views and get their voice heard
AP	Alternative Provision
APPG	All Party Parliamentary Group
Appointee	Someone who has been appointed by the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) to act on another person's behalf in all social security measures
ASC/ASD	Autistic Spectrum Condition/Autistic Spectrum Disorder
Assessments	Different organisations use different assessments to look at the needs of a person to decide if and how they can help
Assistive Technology	The phrase 'assistive technology' is often used to describe products or systems that support and assist individuals with disabilities, restricted mobility or other impairments to perform functions that might otherwise be difficult or impossible
ATU	Assessment and Treatment Unit
BESD	Behavioural, emotional and social difficulties

Best interest decisions	Under the Mental Capacity Act all acts and decisions must be in the person's best interest. A person's capacity (or lack of capacity) refers specifically to their capacity to make a particular decision at the time it needs to be made
BSL	British Sign Language
BSP	Behaviour Support Plan
CAMHS	Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service
Care Manager	A health or social worker who acts as a lead worker for a person
Carers Assessment	Carers are entitled to an assessment of their own needs as a carer. This is the responsibility of the Social Care Service
CCG	Clinical Commissioning Group
СНС	Continuing Healthcare (Adult Heath)
Circle of Support	A group of people, who will support and help a person to say what they want and plan what they want to do. This can include family, friends and social care professionals
Communication Passport	Helps to focus on people's communication when they use actions to communicate a message, rather than or instead of words
Community Care Assessment	An assessment under the NHS & Community Care Act 1990, used to find out what the needs of the individual are
СоР	Code of Practice
Co-Production	The term co-production refers to a way of working whereby everybody works together on an equal basis to create a service or come to a decision which works for them all
СОЅНН	Control of Substances Hazardous to Health
Court of Protection Deputy	Someone appointed by the court to act on the behalf of a person who lacks the mental capacity to make their own decisions regarding financial and personal welfare issues. This is usually a family member

d/Deaf	'd' refers to the physical condition of hearing loss. People who identify with lowercase 'd' don't always have a strong connection with the Deaf community and may have grown up in a hearing community. 'Deaf' with an upper case 'D' is used to describe people who identify as culturally Deaf and actively involved in the Deaf community
