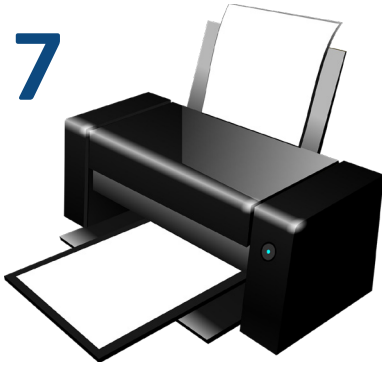

## Section 2: Choose a category



Next, we will ask you to choose a category for your nomination.



A **category** is how we put stories that are similar together.



There are 6 different **categories** that your nomination could go in.



One **category** is Community.

This is for people who are making a difference or getting involved in their local community.



One **category** is sports, arts, entertainment.

This is for people who are doing creative and sporty things.



One **category** is work and education.

This is for people who are in paid work or learning new things.



One **category** is policy and the media.

This is for people who are trying to make their communities or the country a better place with more people included and everyone respected.



One **category** is for people with profound and multiple learning disabilities.



One **category** is for groups.

This is for groups and teams who are working together in any of the other five **categories**.



If you're not sure what category to select don't worry, we will make sure your nomination is in the best category.

If they are chosen as a winner, we will tell people about them and their story.
